Introduction

One Click Export is an [Adobe Premiere](#) extension that helps you to export your work in just one click.

Installation

The easiest and preferred way to install and license is by using the [aescrpts+aeplugins manager app](#).

Refer to the PDF guide [INSTALLING THE TRIAL](#) to try *One Click Export* for free.

It can also be installed using the [aescrpts+aeplugins ZXP installer](#).

After installation is finished, you can access *One Click Export* via *Window -> Extensions -> One Click Export*

Interface

One Click Export has a *main panel* and and a buttons *configuration panel*.

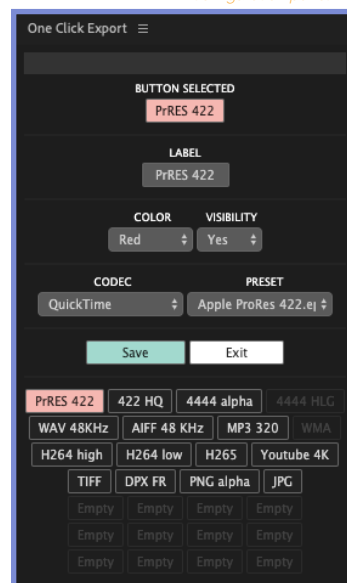
You can access the configuration panel by holding *ALT (on Windows)* or *OPTION (on Mac)* and clicking on any *preset button* or on the top *PR/ME* button.

Main panel



- Select which *program* to export.
- *Option* or *Alt* + click to enter to the *configuration panel*.
- Select which *sequences* to export.
- The source *length* to export.
- *Where* to place the export files.
- *Option* or *Alt* + click on Default, Proj subfolder, Ask, Desktop or link buttons to *open the output folder*.
- The *name* for exporting files.
- All the grid with movie or frame *export buttons*.
- *Option* or *Alt* + click on any button to enter to the *configuration panel*.
- Click on the top-left icon to change between *movie and frame* buttons export.

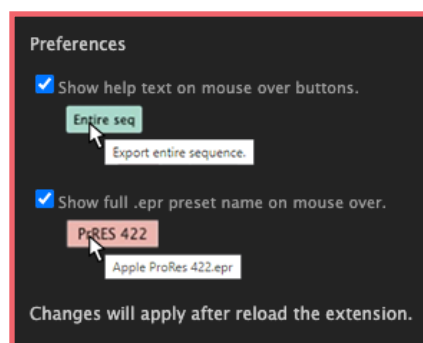
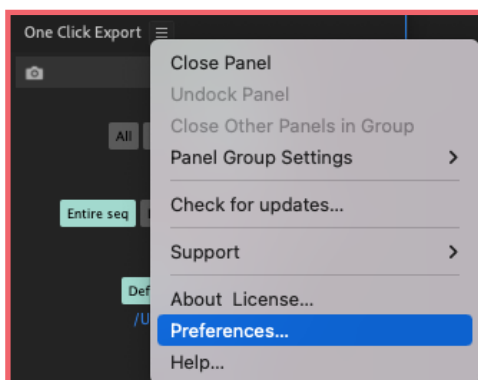
Configuration panel



- The button selected to *make changes*.
- *Option* or *Alt* + click to open the *customized preset files* folder.
- The *label* name.
- The *color* and its *visibility* into *main panel*.
- The family codec and the preset.
- Save the changes or exit to *main panel*.
- *Option* or *Alt* + click on Exit button to restore to *factory defaults*.
- *Shift* + click to restore to *default buttons position*.
- All the grid with movie position buttons.
- Buttons can be *dragged and drop* to interchange their position.

Preferences

To *disable* the pop-up help text on mouse hover, access the *preferences menu* by clicking next to *One Click Export*.



Notes & License

One Click Export is compatible with Adobe Premiere Pro CC2021 (15.1) and later.

The trial version of *One Click Export* is fully functional for **10** days.

After this period, please purchase a full license at <https://aescrpts.com/one-click-export/> or it will stop working.

Known issues

- **Adobe Media Encoder** v.15 on **Mac** has a known issue by Adobe and it does not accept render jobs through scripting. Please select **Adobe Premiere** Render or consider upgrading.
- **IMPORTANT!** Another known issue by Adobe; on **Windows**, the pop-up window to change the path may appear *behind* the main window, only the first time session you launch **Adobe Premiere**. You can locate it on the taskbar or press **ALT+TAB** to find it.



- **BMP** and **GIF** frame export on **Mac** is not supported due to limitations with **Adobe**.
- Some presets may not work depending on the operating system and hardware where *One Click Export* is run.
- If you have any issues with the installer, please refer to the PDF guide **INSTALLING THE TRIAL - One Click Export**.

Local settings

The folder...

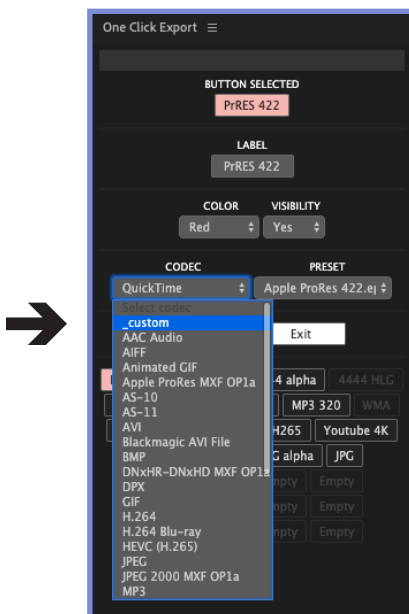
Windows: C:\Users*username*\Documents\OneClickExport

Mac: /Users/*username*/Documents/OneClickExport

... contains user preferences and customized preset files. You must have **write permissions** for this folder.

If you have any problems with *One Click Export* settings, please delete **/Settings** folder and restart the extension.

To add a customized presets to the extension, add **.EPR** files into **/_custom** folder and then refresh the pop-up list.
