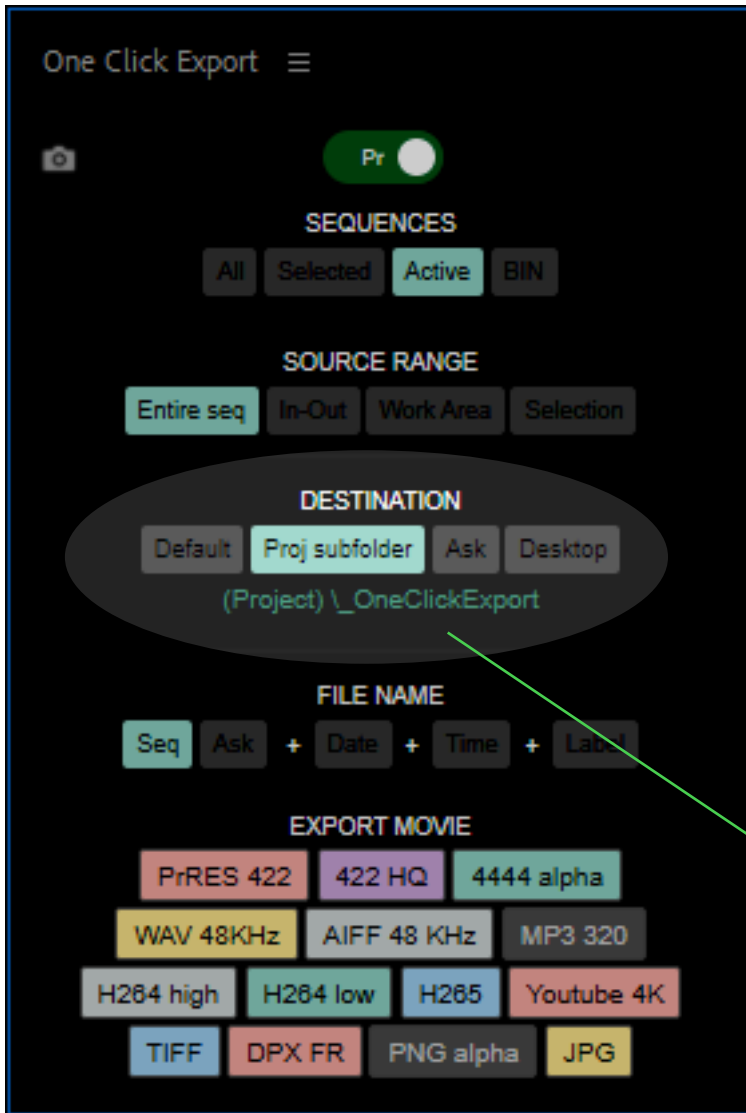

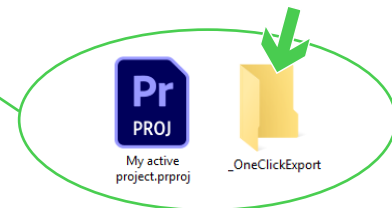
Project subfolder

With version 12.0 (and above) of *One Click Export*, it is possible to export media to a subfolder(s) within the active project path.

To *define* the subfolder(s) structure, click on the *green-colored link* and choose or create subfolder(s) *within* the current active project.

To *open* this subfolder, hold *ALT (on Windows)* or *OPTION (on Mac)* and click on the button "Proj subfolder" or the *green-colored link*.

In summary, once you have selected the "Proj subfolder" option, the export location will always follow this structure regardless of the active project:
current active project folder path + any subfolder(s) you have defined.



In this example, the export is done into the folder called "*_OneClickExport*" located next to the current project.
