



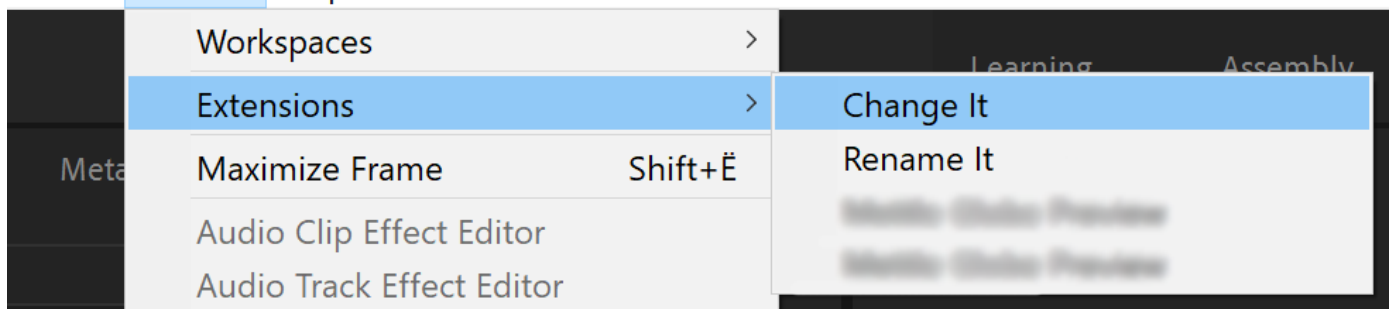
Installation Instructions

Please install “Change it” using “aescrpts + aeplugins ZXP installer” as described here.

IMPORTANT: We guarantee that all functions work in the Premiere 2021 15.4.1 and higher. Versions older than 15.4.1 may not work.

1. Make sure to quit Premiere Pro if it is running.
2. Download and install aescrpts + aeplugins ZXP installer which is available at <http://aescrpts.com/learn/zxp-installer/>
3. Start aescrpts + aeplugins ZXP installer and drag the zxp file of “Change It” onto the installer window
4. If you have any issues, open a support ticket.
5. If you now start Premiere Pro, “Change It” is available in the menu Window->Extensions->Change It

How to use it?

1. Selection panel



Search Items - search sequences in Project Window. If nothing is written in the fields for the search it will change all sequences in the project.


Work with Selected - change or sort the sequences that are selected in Project Windows.

2. Search Attributes

Enter search attributes for the selected item types.



If you know regular expressions in JS, you can use them in your work.

For example, you can find and change items with a serial number from 0 to 4 in the name.

If you need to find a fractional FPS, use a "." dot instead of a "," comma. For example - 23.976

3. Found

In the line "Found" you can see how many items with your attributes are found in Project Windows. (except for situations when you work with selected items)

Changing Sorting 


Functions

Enable or disable the checkbox to use each function individually or together. Thus, you can apply one function or two at once.


1. Changing


- Changes settings for selected or found sequences
- If nothing is written in the fields for the search it will change all sequences in the project.





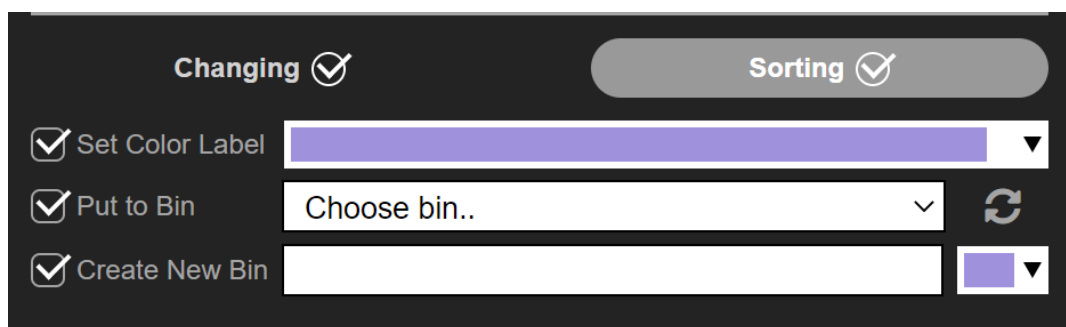

2. Sorting

This will help you organize your project even better!

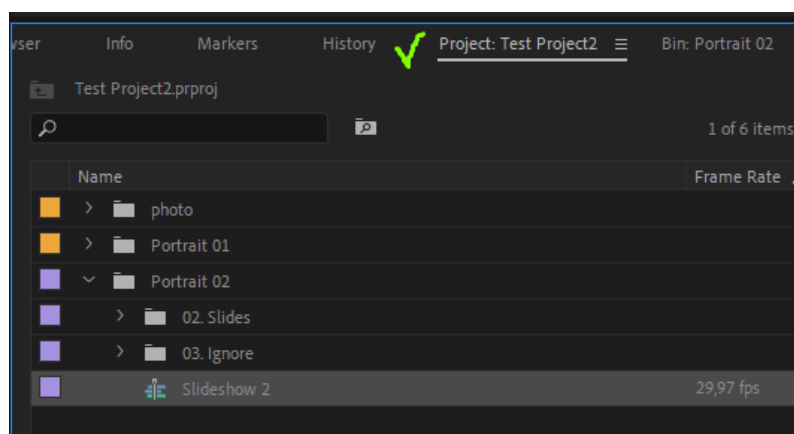


Set Color Label	Change label colors for found or selected sequences.
Put to Bin	Select the bin where you want to move the found or selected sequences.
	Refresh bin list for active project

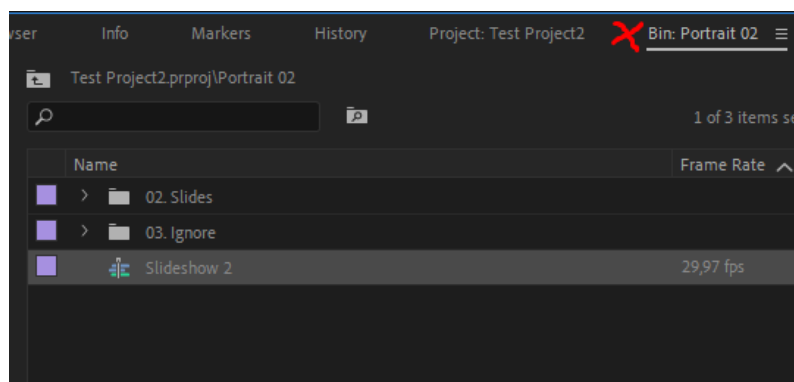
F.A.Q

- Important:** “Change It” works only in the “Project” window. Be careful, because sometimes you can accidentally open the "Bin" window or you really work in it - the extension does not see anything in this window.

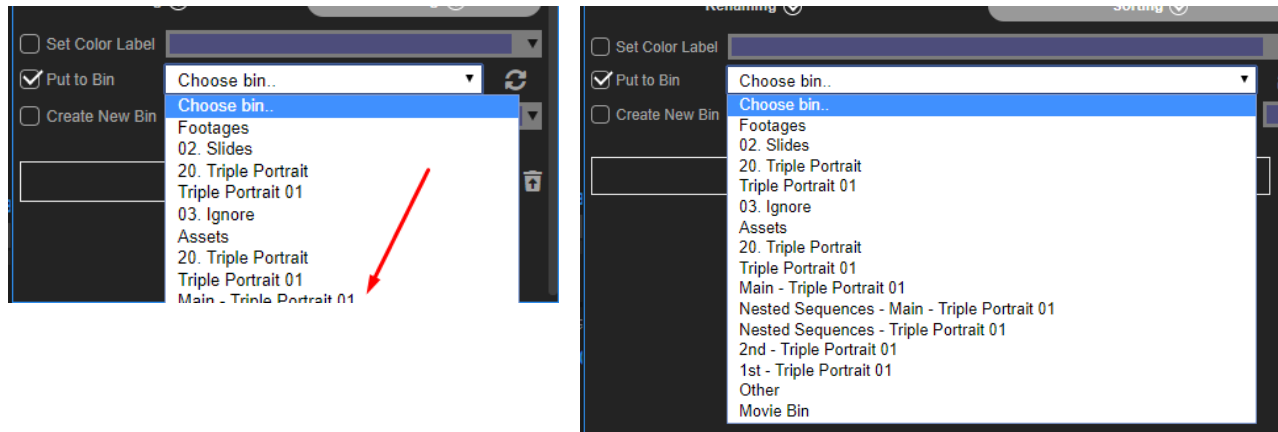
“Project” window

2. MacOS - Sometimes you may not be able to see all available folders. In this case, you just need to expand the extension window.



3. "Extension not work with my sequences."

Please, restart Premiere Pro. So many problems are solved by a simple restart.

And as we found out, the extension may work only with the first open project, it will not work with all subsequent open projects. If you need to fix something in another project - restart Premiere Pro. We are sorry, but this is the problem of Premiere and we can't influence it in any way.

4. You can't undo changing actions, please be sure to save the project before use. We are working on it, but this is a limitation from Adobe.
5. To enter fractional FPS use dot "." not comma ",". For example 23.976
6. Selected sequences can be changed to any fractional value with two character after dot, or to 23.976.
7. You can find integers or fractions like 23.976, 29.97, 59.94. Other fractional values cannot be found.
