



Installation Instructions

The easiest way to install and license Pre-compose Pro is by using the [aescrpts + aeplugins manager](#). To install a trial you can select 'Add Trial' from the 'Account' menu in the app.

Manual Installation

If you want to install Pre-compose Pro manually, here's how:

1. First, close After Effects if it's open.
2. Unzip the zip file that you've downloaded from aescrpts.
3. On macOS, copy the 'PrecomposePro.plugin' to your plugins folder.
4. On Windows, copy 'PrecomposePro.jsxbin' to your Scripts folder.
5. If you're not sure where these folders are, don't worry — here's a handy reminder:

macOS (Plugins)

/Applications/Adobe After Effects (version)/Plug-ins

Windows (Scripts)

Program Files\Adobe\Adobe After Effects (version)\Support Files\Scripts

And that's it! Just reopen After Effects and find Pre-compose Pro in the layer menu (macOS) or launch it by clicking File > Scripts > PrecomposePro.jsxbin (Windows).

You could also attach PrecomposePro.jsxbin to a KBar shortcut.
