



- 1 Quit After Effects
- 2 Copy the "TimeMarker.jsxbin" file into the ScriptUI Panels folder:  
  
**Mac:**  
`/Applications/Adobe After Effects <version>/Scripts/ScriptUI Panels`  
  
**Windows:**  
`C:\Program Files\Adobe\Adobe After Effects <version>\Support Files\Scripts\ScriptUI Panels`
- 3 Open up After Effects again.
- 4 Make sure the **"Allow Scripts to Write Files and Access Network"** checkbox is enabled in **"Preferences > Scripting & Expressions"** (for older versions of After Effects check "Preferences > General")
- 5 Navigate to the Window menu you'll see "TimeMarker.jsxbin" near the bottom.
